Purpose

 This Contract Notification advises RTOs of the mechanism to report assessments of Foundation Skills for Eligible Individuals.

Background

Part B, Clause 11.9 of the VET Funding Contract requires RTOs on the Foundation Skills Approved Provider List to measure an Eligible Individual's skill level at commencement and completion of/withdrawal from a qualification in Domain A and B of the Foundation Skills List.

Main Points

- This Contract Notification sets out the means by which the required information must be reported, and the relevant timeframes.
- Foundation skills assessments must be undertaken using the Australian Core Skills Framework (ACSF) or equivalent framework that aligns with the ACSF as determined by the Department, namely:
 - International Second Language Proficiency Ratings (ISPLR)
 - International English Language Testing System (IELTS)
 - Certificates in Spoken and Written English (CSWE)
 - Certificates in General Education For Adults (CGEA)
- Where testing has been undertaken in an ACSF-equivalent framework, the scores assessed under that framework should be reported as is i.e. there is no need to map them to the ASCF prior to reporting.
- RTOs are reminded of their contractual obligation to keep appropriate documentation. Specifically, RTOs should refer to Clause 10.5(d) of Schedule 1 of the 2014-16 VET Funding Contract for the record keeping requirements in relation to Foundation Skills assessments.
- RTOs to which this requirement extends must report assessment scores via the Skills Victoria Training System (SVTS). A *Foundation Skills Reporting User Guide* is available in the 'Documents' section of SVTS.

Critical Dates

- This Contract Notification is effective immediately.
- Assessments should be reported for in-scope commencements occurring on or after 1 January 2015.
- RTOs must report the finalised data reflecting both commencement and completion scores within 90 days
 of the student completing/withdrawing from the Foundation Skills qualification.
