Student Connect and SSAF

The Student Connect Directorate manages the allocation and expenditure of SSAF. SSAF is allocated to eligible activities which support students across all campuses and modes of study. The major ongoing services supported by SSAF at FedUni is Student Senate, student advisory and advocacy, student engagement, orientation and transition, student development, careers and employment support and clubs, societies, sports and recreation.

In 2018 a new suite of student development programs has been introduced including MasterClasses and the "Impact where you Care" volunteer program. A major focus for Student Engagement has also been the opening of a new Berwick campus. The establishment of clubs, societies, sports and recreation programs, social events and establishing a student lounge have been the main focus for SSAF funding at the Berwick campus.

The Student Senate has also expanded to include representation from the Berwick campus and also had two new positions for Social Inclusion, and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community. The SSAF budget is presented to the Student Senate for consultation and feedback each year and regular reports are provided at each Student Senate meeting.

Student Senate

- The Student Senate was engaged in a number of university boards and committees representing the student body. In particular, Senate members sat of the Academic Board, Learning and Teaching, Respect Now Always, Appeals, and Sustainability committees. The Student Connect portfolio representative met with the Director regularly to discuss how Student Connect can better meet the needs of students. The Gippsland representatives were also heavily engaged in the design and development of the Student Connect services at Gippsland following the closure of the Monash Student Association at that campus, and the Senate representative from Berwick is engaged in setting up the new Campus.
- Senate members are elected by the student body in September for the following year.
