Selective/Conditional Release

Once we know when something is 'complete' other activities, resources & topics can be conditionally released.

What constitutes complete?



Controlling the flow



Not available unless: The activity **What constitutes complete?** is marked complete



Why do this?


- **Completion allows for easy tracking and reports**
- **Selective release allows for progress checking (standards)**
- **Can be used for rewards**
- **For streaming/grouping**
