Glossary

Advanced (Adv.): Courses that are coded 3000 – 3999, advanced-level courses

Co-requisite (CoR): A course or courses that must be completed concurrently with the chosen

course

CR: Credit Point value

**Exclusion (EX):** A course that is the equivalent to another course and so excludes students

from repeating an equivalent course

Introductory (Intro): Courses that are coded 1000 – 1999, introductory-level courses

Intermediate (Inter.): Courses that are coded 2000 - 2999, intermediate-level courses

**Major/Minor:** The main subject area of study completed as part of a degree

Pre-Requisite(s) (PR): A course or courses that must be completed prior to undertaking another

course

Semester: Designated teaching period

**Term:** Designated teaching period
