Important Enrolment Information

Students must complete all the core compulsory courses within the program structure over 4 years (or part-time equivalent).

Students will also be required to complete a total of **eight discipline elective courses** across **two areas of study**. **The first area of study must be either Maths, English or Science**. Students also complete **two Curriculum courses in each Minor study area** for a total of four (see below).

Each course is usually worth 15 credit points.

A total of 480 credit points is compulsory to satisfy the program requirements of Initial Teacher Education (ITE) programs, as well as a minimum of 80 days professional experience. You will also be required to successfully complete external Literacy and Numeracy tests prior to registration as a teacher.

Note: If you wish to apply for course credits, please contact your Program Leader or Student HQ as early as possible.

All Students will be required to have a current Working with Children Check

Minor Discipline Electives

It is a requirement that Pre-Service Teachers (PSTs) complete:

- **Two** Minor Studies of **four discipline elective courses each** (for a total of 8 courses) from **two** discipline sequence/study areas (*The first study area must be either Maths, English or Science*)

AND

- Two Curriculum courses in each Minor area of study (for a total of 4 courses).

Glossary

Semester – designated teaching period

Exclusion (EX) – a course that is the equivalent to another course and so excludes students from repeating an equivalent course

Major/Minor – the main subject area of study completed as part of a degree

Introductory (Intro) – Courses that are coded 1000 – 1999, introductory-level courses

Intermediate (Inter.) – Courses that are coded 2000 – 2999, intermediate-level courses

Advanced (Adv.) – Courses that are coded 3000 – 3999, advanced-level courses
