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Additional Information

This program structure applies to students commencing their TC5 Bachelor of Education Studies (Program Y) program. You must complete all core compulsory courses within the program structure over 3 years (or part-time equivalent), unless you are eligible to transfer into the pathway entry program* (see below).

You will also be required to complete six discipline elective courses in two areas of study. One will be a minor study (4 course sequence) and one will be a part study (2 course sequence).

Each course is usually 15 credit points.

A total of 360 credit points is compulsory to satisfy the program requirements of initial teacher Bachelor of Education programs.

Note: If you wish to apply for course credits, please contact your Program Leader or Student HQ.

If you are unable to, or are having difficulties enrolling in *myStudentCentre*, please contact Student HQ.

*Successful completion of at least one year of the TC5 program may qualify (pending School approval) interested students for transfer into TY5 Bachelor of Education (EC & Primary). Once eligibility has been assessed, students can then apply for credit transfer.

Glossary

Semester – designated teaching period

Co-requisite (CoR) – a selection of courses that need to be completed at the same time

Pre-requisite (PR) – a course or courses that must be completed prior to undertaking another course

CR – Credit Points

Major/Minor – the main subject area of study completed as part of a degree

Level (ie first, second, third) – introductory, intermediate and advanced level courses
