

STATUTE 1.4-THE UNIVERSITY YEAR AND TIMETABLES

1. On the recommendation of the Academic Board:
 - (a) the Vice-Chancellor may from time to time specify the periods into which a year shall be divided and the names by which such periods shall be known;
 - (b) the duration of each of the periods specified under sub-section 1(a) shall be determined in respect of each year by the Vice-Chancellor on or before 31 July of the year immediately preceding that year;
 - (c) a determination made under sub-section 1(b) may specify that one or more of the periods to which that determination relates shall be non-teaching periods;
2. Unless the Vice-Chancellor decides otherwise, instruction in a course shall not be given during any part of a period declared under sub-section 1(c) to be a non-teaching period.
3. On the recommendation of the Academic Board, the Vice-Chancellor may alter any of the periods of a year determined under section 1 for the University or for any School.
4. Any day declared by the Vice-Chancellor to be an appropriate day for the suspension of University business shall be observed as a holiday in the University.
5. The timetable for instruction in any course or unit shall be the responsibility of the Academic Board.

 - (1) The Council may at any time make Regulations, not inconsistent with this Statute, prescribing all matters which by this Statute are required or permitted to be prescribed, or which are necessary or convenient to be prescribed for carrying out or giving effect to this Statute and by later Regulation revoke or amend any such Regulations.
 - (2) Regulations made under this Statute shall be promulgated by being exhibited on the official notice boards of the University and after being so promulgated shall remain so exhibited for at least fourteen days during which time the University is operating.
