### **Recommencement of restricted trade and apprenticeship/traineeship training**

**Wednesday 8 April 2020**

Dear Student,

Federation TAFE is committed to helping combat the spread of COVID-19. We have extensively reviewed our TAFE courses, to identify those that can continue to be delivered in line with current COVID-19 restrictions, those that are suitable for online delivery, and those that require their delivery to be suspended.

I wish to advise you that Federation TAFE will **recommence restricted delivery of selected trade and apprenticeship/traineeship training, including your course, as of Monday 20 April.**

On-campus training will recommence with changes to class structure, size and timetables as well as practical components, to ensure effective implementation of physical distancing and intensive cleaning and hygiene measures in line with advice from the Victorian Chief Health Officer in response to the COVID 19 pandemic.

There will be an impact to existing training plans. Please be assured that Federation TAFE will work with you to complete your training.

**There will be a phased approach to recommencement with individual student attendance dates to be confirmed and you will be contacted by your TAFE course administrator who will provide further detail about your return to training.**

Student services and support will be available. Please check our website or call the particular service you require to find out if it is being provided face-to-face, via phone or online.
