### FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Under the package, eligible students may receive up to \$1,500 of fee relief if you:

- are experiencing financial hardship due to the need to self-isolate
- have had your hours of employment reduced as a result of the pandemic
- are unable to work due to required self-isolation and have limited or no provision of personal or annual leave

### OTHER ASSISTANCE

Students can also request an extension to the due date for tuition fees if they are experiencing financial hardship as a result of the pandemic.

### FIND OUT MORE

To be eligible, you must be currently enrolled as a Federation University student at a partner provider and have experienced reduced income or loss of employment as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.
