Program Requirements

Students must complete all the core compulsory courses within the program structure over 1.5 years (or part-time equivalent).

A total of 240 credit points is compulsory to satisfy the program requirements of Initial Teacher Education (ITE) programs, as well as a minimum of 80 days professional experience. You will also be required to successfully complete external Literacy and Numeracy tests prior to registration as a teacher.

Please note that International Students are not eligible to study this program online.

Students will need to apply for a Working with Children Check (WWCC) card before commencing their program. A copy of the WWCC card must be supplied to the University prior to commencing professional experience placements. More information can be found at the WWCC website.

| Co-requisite (CoR): | A course or courses that must be completed concurrently with the chosen course |

| Exclusion (EX): | A course that is the equivalent to another course and so excludes students from repeating an equivalent course |
| Introductory (Intro): | Courses that are coded 1000 – 1999, introductory-level courses |
