



Coronavirus response - Federation University Australia

Dear Student,

In our proactive efforts to ensure the safety of our community from COVID-19, we wish to alert you to a few public exposure sites in the Berwick and Beaconsfield areas.

While these locations are not related to the University, there are high-volume retail settings listed, which you may have visited at the exposure times.

The following locations are considered **Tier 1 exposure sites**. Anyone who has visited a Tier 1 exposure site during the times listed must immediately isolate, [get a COVID-19 test](#), and quarantine for 14 days from the date of exposure (regardless of returning a negative COVID-19 test). You should also contact the Department of Health on 1300 651 160.

- **Aldi – Beaconsfield, 17 July, 1:30 to 3:00 pm**
- **Shell Coles Express – Berwick, 18 July, 10:30 to 10:55 am**
- **O'Shea Medical Centre – Berwick, 18 July, 8:50 to 10:30 am**
- **Marcos IGA – Narre Warren North, 16 July, 11:25 am to 12:10 pm**

Important information for students

While the vast majority of staff and students are currently working from home, if you must isolate for 14 days, please let your manager, school or teaching staff know. We will make appropriate arrangements to ensure you serve your isolation period in full.

Federation COVID-19 hotline for reporting a COVID test

We need you to let us know if you have had a COVID-19 test and the result of that test, in particular, if you have visited an exposure site or you are confirmed or suspected of having COVID-19. This information will be handled confidentially.

Having this information means if someone is confirmed as having COVID-19 and has attended campus during their infectious period, we can act quickly to put in place a response including concentrated cleaning and assistance with contact tracing.

- During business hours: call the COVID-19 hotline on (03) 5122 6300 (8:30 am to 5:00 pm).
- Outside business hours: call the emergency phone number 1800 333 732 for confirmed cases (positive test result). For a negative result, please call the COVID-19 hotline during business hours.

Exposure site locations are updated regularly, and restrictions can change quickly. Keep up to date at www.coronavirus.vic.gov.au.
