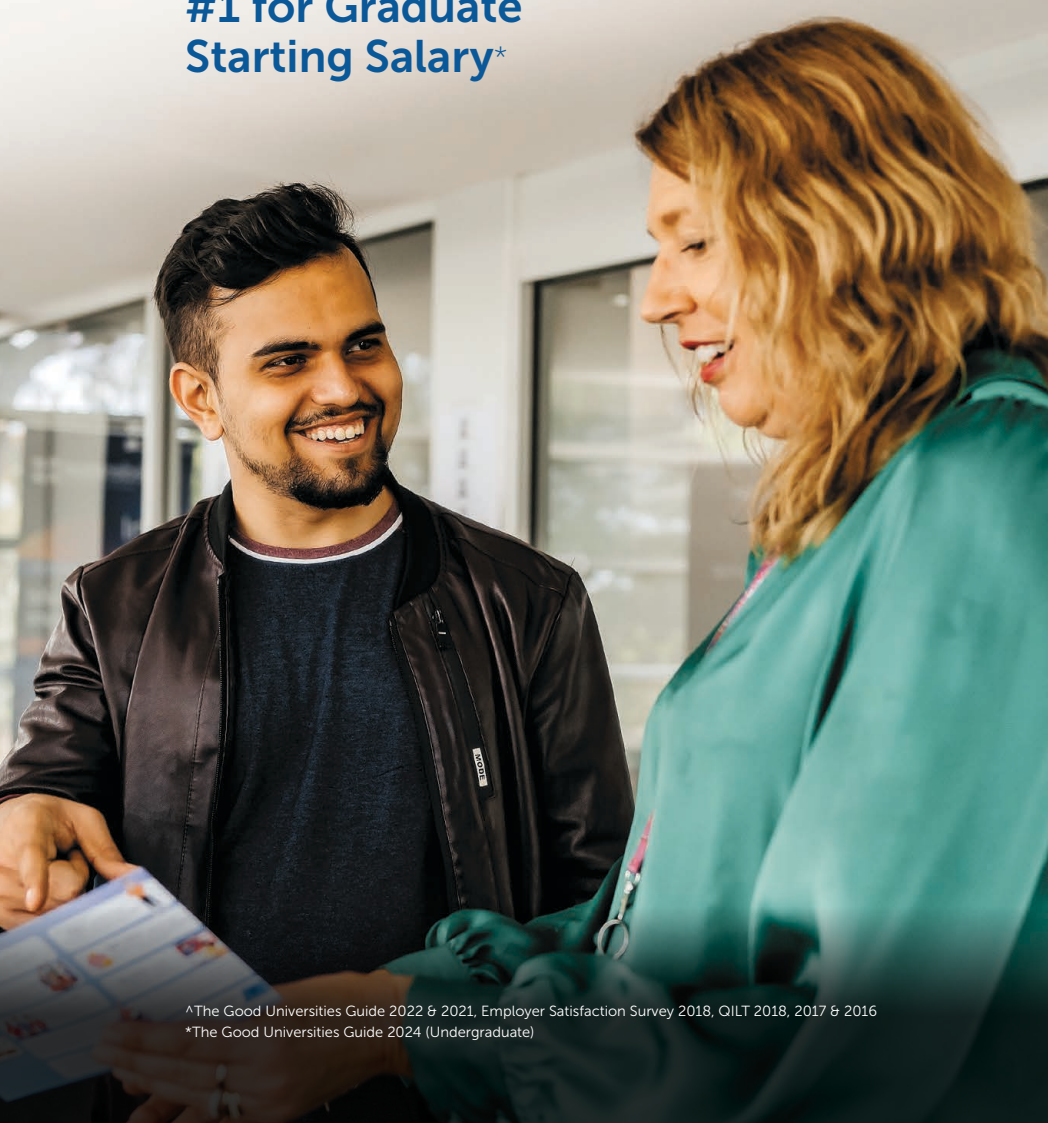

# Your dream career is in high demand

You'll graduate with the skills and confidence needed to land your dream job.

Within the next three years, there will be unprecedented demand for skilled employees across community and professional service jobs. Significant growth in job openings\* is predicted for:

- Aged and Disability Support Carers – **up by 74,900 positions**, or **28%**
- Registered Nurses – **up by 40,400 positions** or **13.9%**
- Software and Application Programmers – **up by 42,200 positions** or **27%**
- Database, Systems Administrators, and ICT Security Specialists – **up by 29,100 positions** or **38.9%**
- Management and Organisation Analyst – **up by 28,200 positions** or **32.2%**
- Human Resource Managers – **up by 19,300 positions** or **16.3%**
