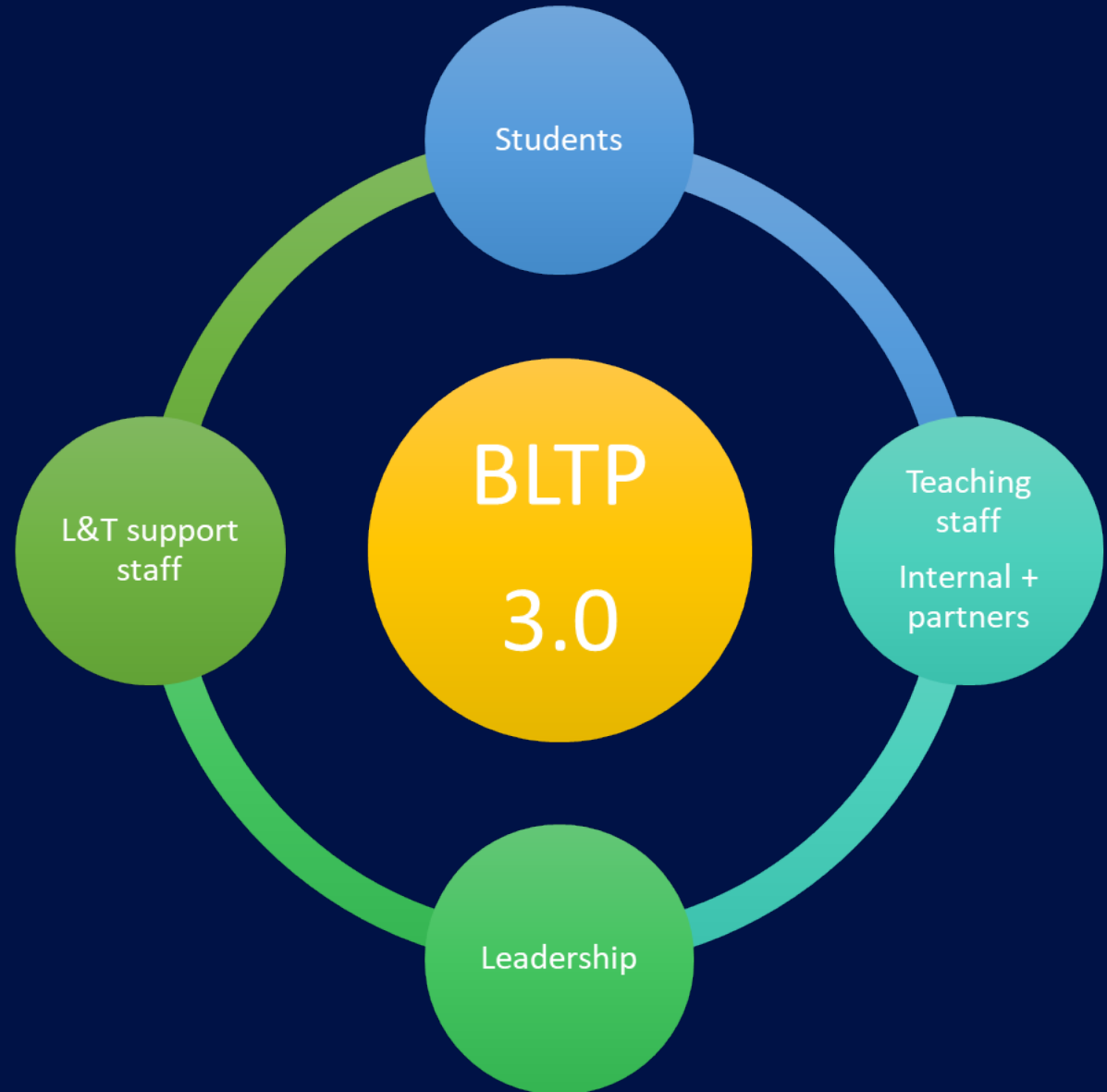
Heat maps
