

Global Scholar Loyalty Grant 2025

International students undertaking a Federation University course through partners at offshore locations, who transfer to Australia to complete their studies or begin a new degree onshore in Australia, will be eligible for a 20% tuition fee scholarship.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the scholarship, applicants must be:

- An international student (not an online student) undertaking a Federation University course offshore, transferring to Australia in 2025 to complete their study or begin a new degree.
- Enrolling as an international student at a Federation University campus to study an applicable course (not study abroad or exchange course) in Australia in 2025.
- Eligible to study in Australia with a valid visa.
- Meet the additional terms and conditions as set out below.

Terms and conditions

1. Applicants must be transferring from an approved Federation University transnational education delivery partner or via the Employability.Life channel.
2. Applicants must be enrolled at a Federation University campus onshore in Australia, studying applicable undergraduate or postgraduate coursework or research courses.
3. The scholarship will be calculated on the full tuition fee for each unit and will be calculated based on the number of units enrolled in, during each semester.
4. If an awardee is approved compassionate or compelling leave from studies for a semester, the scholarship will be reinstated on their return to study.
5. The scholarship is non-refundable and will not be transferred to a cash amount.
6. If an awardee withdraws from the course, they will forfeit the scholarship.
7. The scholarship cannot be deferred for commencement in a future calendar year.

Receipting of Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded in instalments with the first instalment awarded to successful recipients at the time of offer. Ongoing scholarship instalments will be allocated to the awardee's student fee account before the census date each semester.

Right of Appeal

The University regards any decision in relation to these scholarships as final and will not entertain any appeal.
