Glossary

Semester – designated teaching period

Exclusion (EX) – a unit that is the equivalent to another and so excludes students from repeating an equivalent unit.

Course Rules

Counselling: Fail any unit in a Term

Unsatisfactory: Fail >= 50% in a term OR Fail a Unit 2 times

Exclusion: 2 Consecutive Unsatisfactory terms OR fail a Unit 3 times

Commendation: At least 2 units enrolled, ¾ HD and nothing less than a D
