## Graduate Certificate of Education (Tertiary Teaching)

This award program explores the foundations of providing innovative and contemporary learning and teaching practices in the tertiary setting, along with supporting the scholarship of learning and teaching through development of professional practice.

Target group	Anyone with a Bachelors Degree or equivalent, currently or wanting to teach in the higher education sector
Delivery mode	Online, facilitated. Four 15 credit point courses. One course per semester

Tenured contract and sessional staff will have equal opportunity to enrol in the program for each semester of employment	To be eligible to enrol in this program, you must have completed a Bachelor's degree or possess equivalent experience, and preferably be working in a teaching capacity at a tertiary education institution
Course Fees	Federation University staff who are eligible for Commonwealth Supported Place (CSP) funding are EXEMPT from course fees for each semester they are employed with the university.
