## You CAN:

### **Make book chapters and journal articles available online.**

By using the Library's eReserve service:

### **Use Australian TV or radio broadcasts or podcasts.**

### **Play a CD or DVD in a lecture.**

If only staff/students are present.

### **Link to material on the web.**

(Includes embedding YouTube videos) but don't link to sites that you think could infringe copyright.

### **Use electronic images in your teaching slides.**

You must attach the Part VB copyright notice:

(available from 'Notices' under A-Z at

<http://federation.edu.au/copyright>)

**Remember:** access must be restricted to FedUni staff and students and always cite your source.

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## You CANNOT:

**Scan or copy book chapters or journal articles yourself and upload them onto Moodle.**

**Take excerpts from commercial CDs, DVDs or videos to create compilations.**

Instead, use the Library services to make material available – then you can be sure all copyright rules have been followed.
