### Glossary

**Semester:** designated teaching period

**PR:** Pre-requisite, a course or courses that must be completed prior to undertaking another course.

**CO:** Co-requisite, a course or courses that must be simultaneously or prior to undertaking another course.

**EX:** Exclusion, a course or courses that may not be taken.

**CAM:** Camp Street campus, Ballarat

**CHLL:** Churchill campus, Gippsland

### Materials Required

As part of your Studio Practice you will be required to use a diverse range of art materials as these courses comprise of a number of activities with associated costs. A material fee of \$160 per semester (Semester 1, 2 and 3) will cover things such as paper, paint, canvases, wire, glue, tape and gesso but there is also an expectation that as an art student you will purchase items from the "Recommended Material List" which will form a core part of your art supplies for this and subsequent years. In addition the Visual Art studios will supply specialist tools such as electric hand tools and other miscellaneous equipment. The materials fee has been kept to a minimum and is based on group concessions. The amount of \$160 per semester will be added to your student financials account in *myStudentCentre*.

## Recommended Material List

This is a list of items that we **strongly recommend** you purchase for use during your first and subsequent years of study at Federation University Australia and can be purchased from any art or craft retailer.

- Small tool box (to keep your materials in)
- Visual Diaries (these will need to be at least A4 in size) you will need at least 1 for each of your practical subjects
- Range of pencils from HB through to 8B
- Kneadable and vinyl eraser
