## Glossary

<b>Advanced (Adv.):</b>	Courses that are coded 3000 – 3999, advanced-level courses
<b>Co-requisite (CoR):</b>	A course or courses that must be completed concurrently with the chosen course
<b>CR:</b>	Credit Point value
<b>Exclusion (EX):</b>	A course that is the equivalent to another course & so excludes students from repeating an equivalent course
<b>Introductory (Intro):</b>	Courses that are coded 1000 – 1999, introductory-level courses
<b>Intermediate (Inter.):</b>	Courses that are coded 2000 – 2999, intermediate-level courses
<b>Major/Minor:</b>	The main subject area of study completed as part of a degree
<b>Pre-requisite (PR):</b>	A course or courses that must be completed prior to undertaking another course
<b>Semester:</b>	Designated teaching period
<b>Term:</b>	Designated teaching period
