Co-requisite):	A course or courses that must be completed concurrently with the chosen course
CR:	Credit Point value
Exclusion:	A course that is the equivalent to another course and so excludes students from repeating an equivalent course
Introductory (Intro):	Courses that are coded 1000 – 1999, introductory-level courses
Intermediate (Inter.):	Courses that are coded 2000 – 2999, intermediate-level courses
Major/Minor:	The main subject area of study completed as part of a degree
Pre-Requisite:	A course or courses that must be completed prior to undertaking another course
Semester:	Designated teaching period
