

## Coronavirus response - Federation University Australia

I wish to advise you that Federation University will pause teaching activities from **today** at our Brisbane campus and our partner teaching locations in Adelaide, Melbourne and Sydney. **Students are advised not to attend campus.**

This follows the Victorian Government announcement that non-essential services will be closed from Tuesday 24 March to combat the spread of the coronavirus COVID-19.

While universities appear to be exempt from these closures, pausing our teaching activities will allow us to prepare for online delivery of higher education programs from **Monday 30 March** and to seek further clarification from the government on the new measures.

I would like to reassure you that Federation University is well positioned to deal with this situation and we will continue to keep you regularly updated on both the university's response to the COVID-19 pandemic and the online delivery of your program from **Monday 30 March**.
