Respondus – In a nutshell

What it is/does

- It's a special browser that must be installed on the user's computer
- It has optional web cam capture
- It has optional sound capture
- It blocks all other apps
- It blocks access to files


What isn't it/doesn't do

- It's not a quiz tool
- It doesn't control timing, access etc.
- It doesn't capture the desktop
- It doesn't install with admin access to a computer

How does it work

Config in Moodle

- Launch Dashboard
- Click require Lockdown Browser
- Click Require Respondus Monitor





Proctoring

- O Don't require proctoring for this exam
- Require Respondus Monitor (automated proctoring) for this exam [explain]
- Allow instructor live proctoring for this exam (via Zoom, Teams, etc) [explain]


Key points to a successful online test

Students must be given a practice run

- Install the browser
- Check Webcam
- Practice environment check

Clear instructions

- How will the online test be conducted
 - Breaks
 - Allowed materials
 - How to do the environment check and what is acceptable*
 - What to do if tech fails
 - Alternate testing options
 - * A poor environment check undermines the integrity of the process.




The Student experience

Installing Respondus Lockdown Browser

- Downloads can be made from within Moodle
- The version of Respondus is Unique to FedUni
- Students require admin access to their computer
- The system has a built-in check

Starting a Moodle Quiz

 Exactly the same as a regular quiz, but the start button is different



View of Respondus

We can't show this, as the system is locked down

Remember, it's just a browser.
The Moodle quiz will look exactly
the same as in a typical browser

Reviewing attempts

- Reports are generated by Al
- Much like TII they are not a smoking gun
- Things to look for
 - Poor lighting
 - Poor environment scan
 - Background noises
 - Unusual timing









Who supports respondus exams?

Exams Office

- Is first point of contact for information & guidance relating to Respondus eExams
- Administrates a 'Respondus Support' Teams Channel for support & advice on the day of exams (also inc. Course Coordinators, CAD & IT)
- Provides online resources for Respondus eExams
- Timetables all Respondus eExams within exam periods

CAD

- Can doublecheck/confirm Respondus configuration prior to the exam
- Can provide basic support on the day of exam (Business hours AES/DT)
- Cannot provide troubleshooting for internet connectivity issues
- Cannot provide troubleshooting for hardware issues
- May recommend students sit a supplementary exam if problems persist
