## Glossary

Advanced (Adv.): Units that are coded 3000 - 3999, advanced-level units

Co-requisite (CoR): A unit or units that must be completed concurrently with the chosen unit

Pre-requisite (PR): A unit or units that must be completed prior to undertaking another unit

Exclusion(s): A unit that is the equivalent to another unit & so excludes students from repeating an equivalent unit

CR: Credit Point value

**Introductory (Intro):** Units that are coded 1000 – 1999, introductory-level units

Intermediate (Inter.): Units that are coded 2000 – 2999, intermediate-level units

Major/Minor: The main subject area of study completed as part of a degree

Semester: Designated teaching period
