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Additional Information

This program structure applies to students commencing their TZ9 Master of Teaching (Secondary) studies from 2019 at the Mt Helen Campus, Ballarat.

This is an accelerated program which may be completed in 1.5 years, although it is possible for students to complete the program over two or three years on a part-time basis on campus. If you wish to complete the program on a part-time basis, you will need to consult with the Program Leader. Online is offered on a part-time basis only over three years. Please note that not all Specialist Teaching Areas are offered online.

Each course is usually worth 15 credit points, unless otherwise specified. A total of 240 credit points is required.

Glossary

Semester – designated teaching period

Pre-requisite (PR) – a course or courses that must be completed prior to undertaking another course

Co-requisite (CoR) – a course or courses that must be completed concurrently with the chosen course

Exclusion (EX) – a course that is the equivalent to another course and so excludes students from repeating an equivalent course

Major/Minor – the main subject area of study completed as part of a degree

Introductory (Intro) – Courses that are coded 1000 – 1999, introductory-level courses

Intermediate (Inter.) – Courses that are coded 2000 – 2999, intermediate-level courses

Advanced (Adv.) – Courses that are coded 3000 – 3999, advanced-level courses
