Program Requirements

Students must complete all the core compulsory courses within the program structure over 4 years (or part-time equivalent).

Each course is usually worth 15 credit points.

A total of 480 credit points is compulsory to satisfy the program requirements of Initial Teacher Education (ITE) programs, as well as a minimum of 80 days professional experience. You will also be required to successfully complete external Literacy and Numeracy tests prior to registration as a teacher.

Please note that International Students are not eligible to study this program online. Students will need to apply for a Working with Children Check (WWCC) card before commencing their program. A copy of the WWCC card must be supplied to the University prior to commencing professional experience placements. More information can be found at the WWCC website.

Advanced (Adv.):	Courses that are coded 3000 – 3999, advanced-level courses
APAC:	Australian Psychology Accreditation Council
Co-requisite (CoR):	A course or courses that must be completed concurrently with the chosen course
CR:	Credit Point value
Exclusion (EX):	A course that is the equivalent to another course and so excludes students from repeating an equivalent course
Introductory (Intro):	Courses that are coded 1000 – 1999, introductory-level courses
Intermediate (Inter.):	Courses that are coded 2000 – 2999, intermediate-level courses
Major/Minor:	The main subject area of study completed as part of a degree
Pre-Requisite(s) (PR):	A course or courses that must be completed prior to undertaking another course
Semester:	Designated teaching period
Term:	Designated teaching period
