This program structure applies to students commencing their TC5 Bachelor of Education Studies (Program JD) program. You must complete all core compulsory courses within the program structure over 3 years (or part-time equivalent), unless you are eligible to transfer into the pathway entry program* (see below).

You will also be required to complete a minor in two areas of study with six discipline elective courses in each.

Each course is usually 15 credit points.

A total of 360 credit points is compulsory to satisfy the program requirements of the Bachelor of Education studies program.

Note: If you wish to apply for course credits, please contact your Program Leader or Student HQ.

If you are unable to, or are having difficulties enrolling in myStudentCentre, please contact Student HQ.

*Successful completion of at least one year of the TC5 program may qualify (pending School approval) interested students for transfer into one of the Joint Degrees (TA5, TL5, TO5, or TR5). Once eligibility has been assessed, students can then apply for credit transfer.

Glossary

Semester – designated teaching period

Co-requisite (CoR) – a selection of courses that need to be completed at the same time

Pre-requisite (PR) – a course or courses that must be completed prior to undertaking another course

CR – Credit Points

Major/Minor – the main subject area of study completed as part of a degree
