### Pathway/alternate entry

Students who have successfully completed a fourth year of university study may be eligible for 120 credit points upon entry.

### Entry requirements and exit points

- Undergraduate degree in any health discipline or equivalent; or
- Other university qualification and appropriate industry experience

Applicants who hold an undergraduate degree as their highest level of study will be required to undertake introductory units before progressing onto one of the thesis streams.
