

2018 International student accommodation scholarship

Terms and Conditions

Federation International Accommodation Scholarship – for full time undergraduate and postgraduate students commencing studies in 2018.

Duration

The 2018 international accommodation scholarship will apply for the first full academic year term (40 weeks) or 2 consecutive full time semesters of study if commencing mid-year.

Amount

The International student accommodation scholarship is equivalent of up to 100 % of academic year accommodation fees at our Melbourne, Ballarat or Gippsland Campus excludes Brisbane and partner provider teaching locations.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for a scholarship, you must:

- Be a new prospective international student;
- Be eligible to study in Australia with a student visa;
- Have Confirmation of Enrolment (COE) issued by Federation University;
- Be enrolling full time in an eligible program (excluding OS exchange and Study Abroad);
- Be studying full-time at a home campus of Federation University Australia. Home campuses are located in Ballarat, Gippsland and Melbourne.
- Advise FedUni if you will be in receipt of any other scholarship, bursary or reduced fee arrangement at the time of entry to the University;

Eligible programs

To be eligible for a scholarship you must be enrolling in an eligible degree program which is:

- Delivered on campus at Federation University Australia;
- Registered on CRICOS.

Students enrolled in a FedUni EAP program are also eligible for an accommodation scholarship, provided the student's EAP program is packaged with an eligible degree program.

How to apply

There are a limited number of accommodation scholarships available, which will be allocated according to the order in which applications are received. Students are encouraged to apply early via the FedUni Campus Life portal

Students will be automatically assessed for eligibility when applying for an on-campus program at Federation University Australia.

In order to be eligible for a scholarship you must complete your formal accommodation application through the **Campus Life portal** by the due date.

Conditions

1. As a recipient of a scholarship, you must:
 - 1.1. Be enrolled full time in an on-campus undergraduate or postgraduate degree program or a FedUni EAP program packaged with an undergraduate or postgraduate degree program that is, studying at Ballarat, Gippsland or Melbourne campuses of Federation University Australia;
 - 1.2. Behave in a manner which upholds the positive reputation of the University;
 - 1.3. Adhere to the FedUni Living International Scholarship Licence Agreement and Code of Conduct.
 - 1.4. Seek independent advice in relation to implications for taxation and/or effect of the package on other government benefits.
2. The value of your scholarship will be credited directly to your FedUni accommodation account each semester, upon meeting the conditions outlined in 1.
3. The scholarship covers accommodation fees only, which is inclusive of utility costs, furniture, internet, linen and crockery.
4. The package does not cover any other additional costs or services such as meals packages and / or program, activities and special event fees.
5. If you extend your stay outside of academic calendar, you will be required to enter into a new accommodation agreement and pay relevant short -term accommodation fees.
6. The accommodation scholarship is not transferrable.
7. If you withdraw from your degree after close of business on the census date, or if you cease to study at a Federation University campus in Melbourne Ballarat, or Gippsland:
 - 7.1 You will forfeit the scholarship;
 - 7.2 You may be required to vacate your accommodation within 24 hours or pay short term accommodation fees;
 - 7.3 A fee will be payable to vacate covering administrative and cleaning costs.
8. The room allocation will be at the discretion of FedUni Living.
9. The scholarship cannot be deferred.

Right of appeal in respect of the scholarship for accommodation - The University regards any decision in relation to these scholarships as final and will not entertain any appeal.
