

IEEE workshops – “Authorship: Learn about the research process, integrity and ethics in publishing and “Techniques for effective research with IEEE Xplore” – 24 July 2018

On 24 July 2018, the Centre for Informatics and Applied Optimization (CIAO) hosted two research workshops on “Authorship: Learn about the research process, integrity and ethics in publishing” and “Techniques for effective research with IEEE Xplore”, which were held at the Federation University Australia, Mt Helen Campus.

The aim of the workshops was to inform researchers of some secrets of the trade in research collaborations and publishing, and to learn about techniques for effective research with IEEE Xplore.

The event was streamed to the other campuses of FedUni, at Berwick and Churchill. Twenty people attended the event in Mt Helen and two people attended from Berwick and Churchill.

The workshop commenced with a welcome from the director of CIAO, Associate Professor Alex Kruger who introduced Alex Liu Yipeng from IEEE Singapore Section, who gave an instrumental talk on authorship, integrity and ethical issues in publishing. A Panel Discussion followed the presentation and consisted of Associate Professor Andrew Stranieri, Dr Mehmood Chadhar, and Alex Liu Yipeng. A number of challenging questions in regards to authorship were asked by the participants, and lively discussion ensued.

Lunch and refreshments were provided by IEEE FedUni Ballarat Branch for participants. During the lunch, Dr. Alireza Jolfaei encouraged students to join the FedUni IEEE student branch. The feedback received from participants was very positive.

After lunch the second workshop was held in the Mt Helen library. Alex Liu Yipeng gave a second talk on techniques for effective research with IEEE Xplore. The event was closed by the research, learning and liaison team of the FedUni library.
