### Course Requirements

Students must complete all the core compulsory courses within the program structure over 4 years (or part-time equivalent).

Students will also be required to complete a total of eight discipline elective courses across two areas of study. The first area of study must be either Maths, English or Science. Students also complete two Curriculum courses in each Minor study area for a total of four (see below).

Each course is usually worth 15 credit points.

A total of 480 credit points is compulsory to satisfy the program requirements of Initial Teacher Education (ITE) programs, as well as a minimum of 80 days professional experience. You will also be required to successfully complete external Literacy and Numeracy tests prior to registration as a teacher.

Please note that International Students are not eligible to study this program online.

Students will need to apply for a Working with Children Check (WWCC) card before commencing their program. A copy of the WWCC card must be supplied to the University prior to commencing professional experience placements. More information can be found at the WWCC website.

### Minor Discipline Electives

It is a requirement that Pre-Service Teachers (PSTs) complete:

- Two Minor Studies of four discipline elective courses each (for a total of 8 courses) from two discipline sequence/study areas (The first study area must be either Maths, English or Science)

plus

- Two Curriculum courses in each Minor area of study (for a total of 4 courses).

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## Glossary

<b>Co-requisite (CoR):</b>	A unit or units that must be completed concurrently with the chosen unit
<b>Pre-requisite (PR):</b>	A unit or units that must be completed prior to undertaking another unit
<b>Exclusion(s)(EX):</b>	A unit that is the equivalent to another unit & so excludes students from repeating an equivalent unit
<b>Introductory (Intro):</b>	Units that are coded 1000 – 1999, introductory-level units
<b>Intermediate (Inter.):</b>	Units that are coded 2000 – 2999, intermediate-level units
<b>Advanced (Adv.):</b>	Units that are coded 3000 – 3999, advanced-level units
<b>Major/Minor:</b>	The main subject area of study completed as part of a degree
<b>Semester:</b>	Designated teaching period
<b>CR:</b>	Credit Point value
