Information on prizes and how to enter form part of these Terms and Conditions of Entry ("the Conditions").

By entering this Promotion, all Entrants will be deemed to have accepted and agreed to be bound by these terms and conditions.

The Terms and Conditions of this Promotion are governed by the laws of the State of Victoria.

Entry to the Promotion is open to all current Federation University students at the time of entry into the Promotion. The winning entrant and the 'winning entries' will be the ones drawn randomly first and in succession, by the judges (3 in total) at Federation University's Student Equity Office. The winning Entrants will be announced on the official Federation University Australia Current Students Meta pages and will also be notified via email within 24 hours of the competition closing date. Judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

The first complete entry randomly selected will receive a \$200 Prezzee gift voucher. An additional 1 randomly drawn entry will also receive a gift voucher to the value of \$200.
