Important Enrolment Information

In order to qualify for the degree of Bachelor of Criminology and Criminal Justice, students must satisfactorily complete a total of 360 credit points. All students must complete one of the following two options as part of their program:

Option 1: A Major consisting of 8 courses from one of the following study areas: Sociology, Community and Human Services, Behavioural Studies, or IT Security.

Option 2: Two Minors of 4 courses each from the following study areas: Indigenous Studies, Sociology, Writing, Community and Human Services, Behavioural Studies or IT Security.

Additionally:

Students must successfully complete CRJUS 1285 and CRJUS 1287 prior to commencing a second- or third-year course, except for CRJUS 2475, which is offered in first year second semester.

Students must complete a minimum of 60 points at intermediate level (second year) core CRJUS courses before enrolling in advanced third year core CRJUS courses.

Students must complete a minimum of 90 points at advanced (third year level).

Exclusion (EX):	A course that is the equivalent to another course and so excludes students from repeating an equivalent course
Introductory (Intro):	Courses that are coded 1000 – 1999, introductory-level courses
Intermediate (Inter.):	Courses that are coded 2000 – 2999, intermediate-level courses
Major/Minor:	The main subject area of study completed as part of a degree
Pre-Requisite(s) (PR):	A course or courses that must be completed prior to undertaking another course
Semester:	Designated teaching period
Term:	Designated teaching period
