If you have COVID-19 symptoms, get tested and self-isolate until you receive a negative test result. If you test positive, advise us on (03) 5122 6300 between 8.30 am and 5.00 pm. ## Student attendance on campus

We no longer have restrictions on when you can be on campus – unless there is a temporary closure at the direction of government or as the result of a COVID-19 incident. You must adhere to any 'maximum density' signage, and follow the directions of staff regarding space allocation. This advice is subject to change in line with Victorian government guidelines.

## When to 'check-in' on campus

When you access a communal space on campus, you must 'check-in' using the QR codes available. This includes the Library, cafes and eateries, university services (Student HQ etc), computer labs and study spaces etc.

1. Install and open the [Service Victoria app](#) on your phone or mobile device.
  2. Scan the QR code available on posters, tables and near the doors of communal spaces, and follow the prompts to check-in.
  3. Submit your details and check for the green success tick.

## COVID-19 incidents

If we have a confirmed case of COVID-19 on campus, impacted students will be contacted. We will identify the appropriate students via class timetables and the records from our QR 'check-in' processes. It is vital that we can contact you if we need to; you must keep your contact details current in your [my Student Centre](#) account. Learn how to update them [here](#).

## Cleaning of shared items

You are asked to wipe down shared items, such as computer equipment, chairs and table surfaces, with the provided sanitising wipes before and after each use. We have increased the cleaning schedules around campus, but need you to take an active role as well.

## Face masks

You must comply with all [COVID-19 government directives](#), including the wearing of face masks, applicable at the campus you are attending.

It is strongly recommended to wear these where physical distancing of 1.5m cannot be achieved.

## Hand hygiene

Be diligent in your personal hygiene practices. Wash your hands frequently, and make use of the hand sanitising stations installed around campus.
