Dear colleagues,

The Queensland Government has issued new COVID-19 restrictions for the Greater Brisbane area, following confirmed cases of community transmission of COVID-19.

Brisbane Campus is now temporarily closed and is scheduled to re-open on Wednesday 7 April, following the Easter break.

Restrictions in Victoria remain unchanged.

Three-day lockdown for Greater Brisbane

Residents in the Queensland council areas of Ipswich, Logan, Redlands, Moreton and Brisbane must stay at home until 5:00 pm, Thursday 1 April.

People in Greater Brisbane can only leave their homes for essential reasons like grocery shopping, exercise, work and medical care. When leaving your home, masks are mandatory.

The restrictions will be reviewed by the Queensland Government on Wednesday night 31 March 2021.

Students and staff working at Federation's Brisbane Campus have been advised of the closure and please be patient as they adjust they return to working remotely during this time.
