

# Academic Induction Program



The Academic Induction Program (AIP) is a formalised support for higher education teaching staff new, or returning, to Federation University. All staff, whether sessional, contract or ongoing, are expected to complete this 15 hour blended program within their probation period.

Academic staff are provided with an introduction to:

- general and specific Federation University learning and teaching practices
- learning technologies to support university learning and teaching initiatives
- support networks available for academic wellbeing and enhancing learning and teaching practices
- support networks available to aid student retention and learning success

## PROGRAM OVERVIEW

### PART A - ONLINE | Pre-workshop

This component of the program can be completed at any time, and preferably BEFORE you attend a face-to-face workshop.

- Time allocation: 6 hours

### PART B - ON CAMPUS | Workshop

This element of the program is a single day workshop on-campus. A morning session from 9:30am - 12:30pm and afternoon session from 1:15pm - 4:15pm. Learnings from this day will help consolidate the information provided in Part A, and provide opportunities for networking with key learning and teaching personnel on your campus.

- Time allocation: 6 hours

### PART C - ONLINE | Post-workshop

Four online units AFTER attending an on-campus workshop. This needs to be completed within four (4) weeks post-workshop attendance. Your understanding of elements within these units will be assessed at the end via a completion quiz.

- Time allocation: 3 hours
- Access to Part C will be accessible after completion of Part A and attendance at Part C
