

## Important Enrolment Information

Please note: continuous online engagement is expected throughout the study period.

This program is delivered sequentially over the course of two years fulltime, or part-time equivalent. Approximately 6 to 8 weeks is allocated to the delivery of each course within the program, with each class taking place fortnightly on alternating Fridays. Each course within the program is typically worth 15 credit points each, with the exception of Field Placement courses worth 45 credit points each. For students wishing to apply for course credits and/or recognition of prior learning (RPL), please ensure that you do so prior to the commencement of this program.
