#### **Course Requirements**

Students must complete all the core compulsory units within the course structure over 4 years (or part-time equivalent).

Students will also be required to complete a total of **twelve discipline elective units** across **two areas of study**. Students also complete **two Curriculum units** in each Major study area for a total for four (see below.

Each unit is usually worth 15 credit points.

A total of 480 credit points is compulsory to satisfy the course requirements of Initial Teacher Education (ITE) course, as well as a minimum of 80 days professional experience. You will also be required to successfully complete external Literacy and Numeracy tests prior to registration as a teacher.

Please note that International Students are not eligible to study this course online.

Students will need to apply for a Working with Children Check (WWCC) card before commencing their course. A copyof the WWCC card must be supplied to the University prior to commencing professional experience placements. More information can be found at the WWCC website.

#### **Major Discipline Electives**

It is a requirement that Pre-Service Teachers (PSTs) complete:

- Two Major Studies of six discipline elective units each (for a total of 12 units) from two discipline sequence/study areas plus
- Two Curriculum units in each Major area of study (for a total of 4 units)

**Exclusion(s)(EX):** A unit that is the equivalent to another unit & so excludes students from repeating an equivalent

unit

**Introductory (Intro):** Units that are coded 1000 – 1999, introductory-level units

**Intermediate (Inter.):** Units that are coded 2000 – 2999, intermediate-level units

**Advanced (Adv.):** Units that are coded 3000 – 3999, advanced-level units

**Major/Minor:** The main subject area of study completed as part of a degree
