

# **Bushfire Emergency Plan**

## **Mt Helen Campus**

During periods of high bushfire alert, staff and students are encouraged not to use Campus facilities outside normal office hours.

The following procedures are provided for your safety and welfare while on campus during times of high fire danger. In the event the Campus comes under threat due to a bushfire approaching the area:

Occupants must follow directions outlined in the Local Emergency Instructions.

Follow further instructions as directed by the Area and Campus Wardens or Emergency Services Personnel.

#### LOCAL EMERGENCY INSTRUCTIONS IN THE EVENT OF A BUSHFIRE

- Contact 000.
- · Answer all emergency operator questions.
- Notify the Property and Infrastructure Office on 5327 9520.
- Close all external doors and windows in immediate vicinity (do not lock), placing door mats inside if safe to do so.
- Remain inside, preferably on ground floor level, and await further instructions from Area or Campus Wardens or Emergency Services Personnel.
- · Avoid leaving building unless directed to do so.
- Avoid driving vehicles, as this can lead to congestion of local roads and slow emergency vehicle response.
