

Early Bird Bursary

Semester 2 2025

The bursary is available to international students commencing in Semester 2, 2025 who have accepted an unconditional offer and paid a deposit by 11:59 AEST on Friday 23 May 2025. Successful applicants receive a \$3,000 AUD discount on their tuition fees in the first semester of their second year of study.

Summer Semester - Offshore Early Bird Bursary

The bursary is available to international students applying from outside Australia, commencing in the Summer Semester of 2025 who have accepted an unconditional offer and paid a deposit by 11:59 AEST on Friday 29 August 2025. Successful applicants receive a \$3,000 AUD discount on their tuition fees in the first semester of their second year of study.

Summer Semester - Onshore Early Bird Bursary

The bursary is available to international students applying from within Australia, commencing in the Summer Semester of 2025 who have accepted an unconditional offer and paid a deposit by 11:59 AEST on Monday 27 October 2025. Successful applicants receive a \$3,000 AUD discount on their tuition fees in the first semester of their second year of study.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the bursary, applicants must be:

- A fee-paying international student (not a study abroad, exchange or online student)
- Enrolling as a commencing student in 2025
- Eligible to study in Australia with a valid visa.
- Meet the additional terms and conditions as set out below.

Terms and conditions

- 1. Applicants must be enrolled in a Federation University Australia, undergraduate or postgraduate coursework degree.
- 2. Applicants are required to have accepted their offer letter for commencement in 2025 and paid fees due as outlined in the International Student Offer and Acceptance Agreement
- 3. The bursary will be paid as a tuition fee discount and will be applied in Semester 1 of your second year of study.
- 4. The bursary is non-refundable and may not be transferred to a cash amount.
- 5. If an awardee withdraws from the course, they will forfeit the bursary.
- 6. The bursary cannot be deferred for commencement in a future calendar year.

Receipting of Bursary

This bursary is awarded as a tuition fee discount in Semester 1 of your second year of study.

Right of Appeal

The University regards any decision in relation to these bursaries as final and will not entertain any appeal.
