Semester – designated teaching period Pre-requisite (PR) – a unit or units that must be completed prior to undertaking another unit Co-requisite (CoR) – a unit or units that must be completed concurrently with the chosen unit Exclusion (EX) – a unit that is the equivalent to another and so excludes students from repeating an equivalent unit

Course Rules Counselling: Fail any unit in a Term Unsatisfactory: Fail >= 50% in a term OR Fail a Unit 2 times Exclusion: 2 Consecutive Unsatisfactory terms OR fail a Unit 3 times Commendation: <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> HD and nothing less than a D
