### **Glossary**

Semester – designated teaching period

**Pre-requisite (PR)** – a unit or unit that must be completed prior to undertaking another unit **Co-requisite (CoR)** – a unit or unit that must be completed concurrently with the chosen unit

Exclusion (EX) – a unit that is the equivalent to another and so excludes students from repeating an equivalent unit

#### **Course Rules**

Counselling: Fail any unit in a Term

Unsatisfactory: Fail >= 50% in a term OR Fail a Unit 2 times

Exclusion: 2 Consecutive Unsatisfactory terms OR fail a Unit 3 times

Commendation: 3/4 HD and nothing less than a D
