Share and re-use existing resources

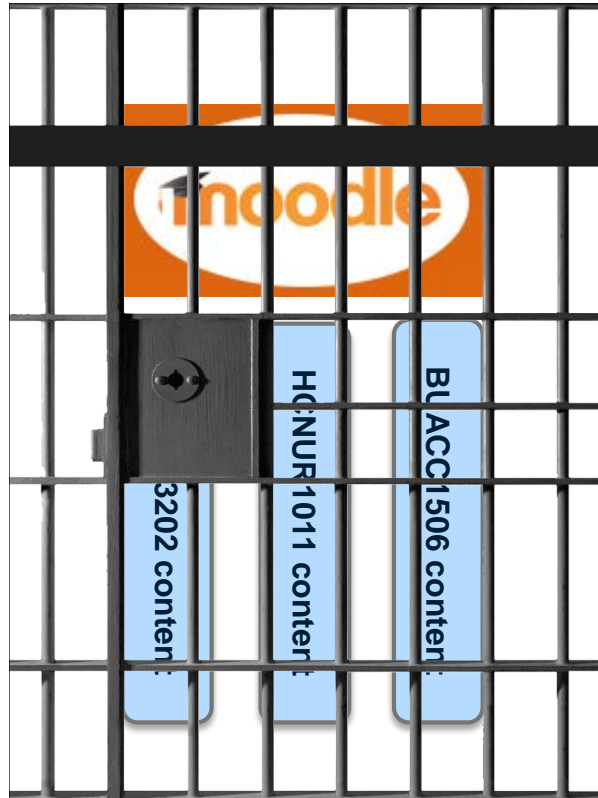

What is Equella?



How Moodle currently stores files



- Silo based
- Restricted access to content for teaching staff limits potential re-use
- Poor multimedia handling
 - Video resources reduce Moodle performance and stability
- Locked away, discourages sharing

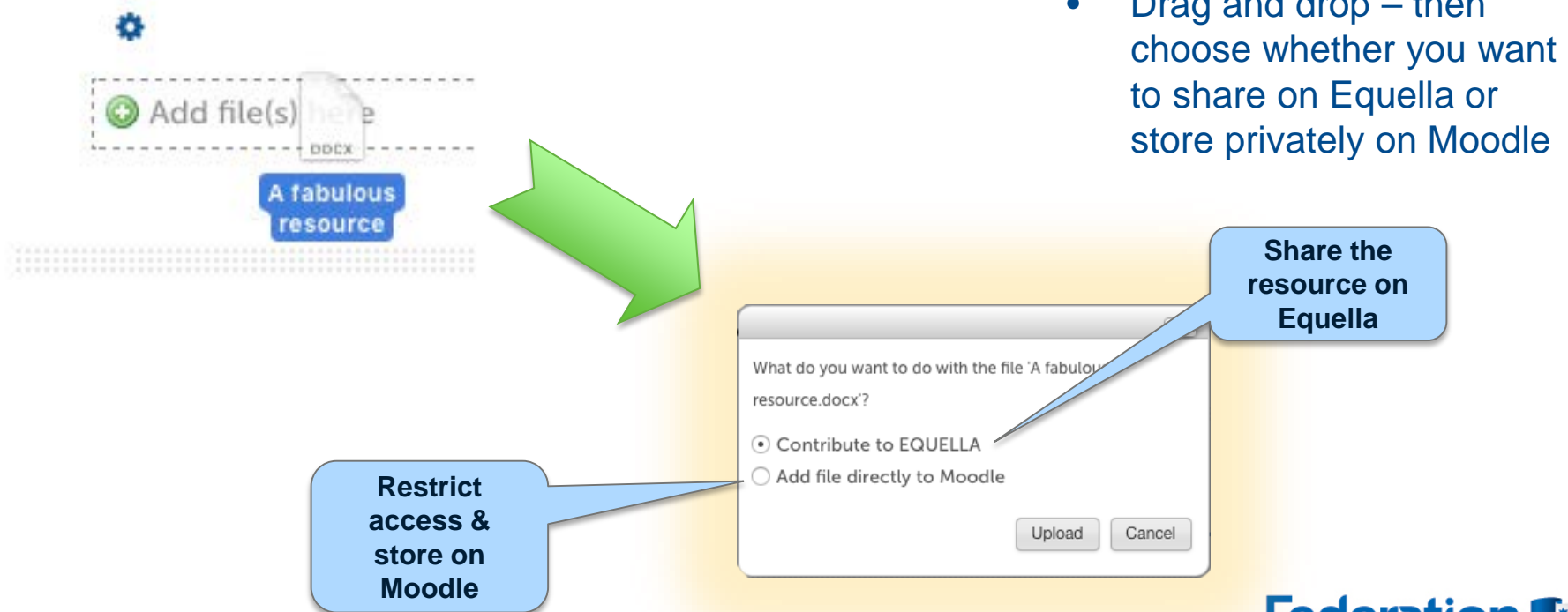
