- Contribute easily to a shared pool of resources



# How Moodle currently stores files



- Silo based
- Restricted access to content for teaching staff limits potential re-use
- Poor multimedia handling
  - Video resources reduce Moodle performance and stability
- Locked away, discourages sharing

Shared – stored on Equella


- Instructional videos

When you share content through Equella, you're contributing to a pool of resources that will benefit all Federation University staff.


