2020 Overseas Study Tour

The New Colombo Plan (NCP) tour is funded by a signature initiative of the Australian Government that supports Australian undergraduate students to participate in short-term study tours across the Indo-Pacific region.

Are you:

- an undergraduate, domestic student enrolled in a Federation Business School Bachelor degree?
- 18 to 28 years old inclusive at the commencement of the NCP project (depending on the study tour, exceptions may apply to those over 28 years old) and must not have received a NCP grant previously.
- able to attend all the pre-departure meetings / sessions?
- able to enrol into BUEXC3504 International Study Exchange (15CP) and meet pre-requisites of the successful completion of 8 courses (120 credit points), which involves tour participation and completion of course requirements.

What do these tours involve?

- Two to three weeks in country as a part of a student group, plus a Federation Business School staff member as leader.
- A travel scholarship towards the cost of airfares, accommodation, travel insurance and activities.
- Students to enrol in BUEXC3504, involving tour participation and completion of course requirements.
- Visit to national universities, study in the host location, industry tours and cultural experiences.

- Develop your understanding of our neighbouring region – learn through the eyes of a local
- Career and professional development - through problem solving, teamwork, understanding cultures and working with different people
