As you may be aware, the Victorian Government has announced it will close all non-essential services from Tuesday 24 March to combat the spread of the coronavirus COVID-19.

The [statement from the Premier](#) does not specify whether this applies to universities.

We have been in contact with the Department of Education and have been advised further announcements will be made by the government to clarify this tomorrow, Monday 23 March.

Until advised by government, we will continue to deliver face-to-face teaching on our campuses.

This means you should attend your classes on campus on Monday 23 March unless you are sick or in required self-isolation.

We will continue to keep you updated about this rapidly changing situation. We are in close contact with government and will provide more detailed information to students following further government announcements expected on Monday 23 March.
