**Important Enrolment Information**

A discipline major consists of 8 courses (120 credit points) and is made up of:

- 1 x Introductory level course = 15 credit points (usually completed in 1st year)
- 2 x Intermediate level courses = 30 credit points (usually completed in 2nd year)
- 2 x Advanced level courses = 30 credit points (usually completed in 3rd year)
- 3 x additional courses at Introductory, Intermediate or Advanced level in the discipline = 45 credit points.

A minor sequence consists of 4 courses (60 credit points) and is made up of:

- 1 x Introductory level course = 15 credit points (usually completed in 1st year)
- 3 x additional courses at Introductory, Intermediate or Advanced level in the discipline = 45 credit points

All students must complete 1 Major of 8 courses (120 credit points) and 1 Minor of 4 courses (60 credit points). Students also have the option of doing a Double-major, which consists of 2 discipline areas with 120 credit points in each, with no minor.

No more than 10 courses (150 credit points) can be taken at 1st year/Introductory level in the program.

Major options: History, Sociology, Indigenous Studies, Philosophy, English/Literature, Writing, Japanese, Media & Screen Studies, Psychology (APAC), Global & International Studies.

A Psychology (APAC) major consists of 12 courses (15 for students who commenced in 2018). These courses are all compulsory for APAC accreditation.

Minor options: History, Sociology, Indigenous Studies, Philosophy, English/Literature, Writing, Japanese, Media & Screen Studies, Psychology (APAC) OR Behavioural Studies, Criminal Justice, Global & International Studies, Community & Human Services, Politics, or Education Studies.

Students completing a major or minor in Philosophy or Global and International Studies or a minor in Politics should contact their Program Coordinator to discuss their options.
