VDC's Teaching Fellowship Program will consist of several components:

- In-person workshops focusing on best teaching practice
- A Masterclass to develop leadership and organisational skills
- A Community of Practice which will provide fellows the opportunity to work together on a group research project (Action Research Project)
- The opportunity to attend and present the Action Research Project at VDC's annual Teaching & Learning Conference.
