Glossary

Semester – designated teaching period

Pre-requisite (PR) – a course or courses that must be completed prior to undertaking another course **Co-requisite** (CoR) – a course or courses that must be completed concurrently with the chosen course **Exclusion** (EX) – a course that is the equivalent to another and so excludes students from repeating an equivalent course
