Subject:	Retaining evidence when a student presents a digital concession card

Purpose

This Contract Notification is to advise RTOs of an amendment to the Guidelines About Fees regarding retention of evidence of concession when a student presents a digital concession card.

Background

- Clause 3.4 of the Guidelines About Fees requires that where a concession card is presented to the RTO via a Digital Wallet through a Centrelink Express Plus mobile application, the RTO must sight and authenticate the card by viewing the card directly through the Centrelink Express Plus mobile application on the cardholder's mobile device.
- Clause 3.9 (a) of the Guidelines About Fees currently requires that where a concession card is presented via the
 Digital Wallet, the RTO must <u>retain</u> a copy electronically, as produced via a screenshot generated by the
 cardholder's mobile device.
- The Department has been made aware that Centrelink has introduced a new security measure to its Centrelink Express Plus mobile application that prevents students from taking a screenshot of their digital concession card and RTOs are no longer able to comply with the requirements of Clause 3.9 (a) as they are currently written.

Main Points

- RTOs are advised that Clause 3.9 of the Guidelines About Fees is varied as follows:
 - 3.9 The RTO must retain a copy of the relevant concession card specified at Clause 3.7:
 - a. in hard copy or electronically scanned copy where a physical card is presented; or
 - b. its equivalent record as extracted from Centrelink Confirmation eServices; or where the concession card is presented via a Digital Wallet through a Centrelink Express Plus mobile application, of which a copy is not possible, the RTO must make a written declaration and attach it to the student's file stating that the digital concession card has been sighted in accordance with Clause 3.7. The declaration must include:
 - Name of the authorised delegate who sighted the digital concession card;
 - Date the digital concession card was sighted;
 - Document number of the concession card; and
 - Name of concession holder.
