Additional Information

This program structure applies to students commencing their TC5 Bachelor of Education Studies (Program Y) program.

- You must complete all core compulsory courses within the program structure over 3 years (or part-time equivalent) unless you are eligible to transfer into the pathway entry program* (see below).
- You will also be required to complete six discipline elective courses in two areas of study. One will be a minor study (4 course sequence) and one will be a part study (2 course sequence).
- Each course is usually 15 credit points.
- A total of 360 credit points is compulsory to satisfy the program requirements of the Bachelor of Education Studies program.

Note: If you wish to apply for course credits, please contact your Program Coordinator or Student Administration. If you are unable to, or are having difficulties enrolling in myStudentCentre, please contact Student Administration.

*Successful completion of at least one year of the TC5 program may qualify (pending School approval) interested students for transfer into TY5 Bachelor of Education (EC & Primary). Once eligibility has been assessed, students can then apply for credit transfer.
